All courses have a [standard operating procedure](#) for onboarding instructors. This document describes the minimum requirements for all instructors for any course.

All instructors delivering the DASA DevOps Fundamentals must also meet the following additional criteria:

- No formal accreditation for trainers is required. The training partner is responsible for ensuring the trainer meets the requirements relevant for trainers.
- This means that trainers must have passed the exam 10% higher than the passing grade, they have attended a Train the Trainer session, and have experience in the DevOps domain.
